DLI 5.3 MODULE 1: STRENGTHENING OF TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER

TASKS:

Establish University innovation/entrepreneurship ecosystem through the strengthening of the Technology Transfer Office (TTO).

A physical 5-day workshop for potential TTOs identified by the University and ACEDHARS (faculty) will be carried to train personnel in the act of Technology Transfer. The University Innovation and Technology Management Office (ITMO) which was carved out of the Research and Innovation Office about a year ago is still without one competent TTO. Therefore, a *professional TTO from Penn State University, USA who has agreed to mentor the ITMO will facilitate the workshop along with professional Intellectual property, Entrepreneurship experts within the University. The trained TTOs will also do some practical demonstrations of lessons learnt which will be judged by invited experts from the industry.

*Note: Unfortunately, the person died during the preparation for the workshop, and another TTO was contracted from South Africa.

REPORT

A. TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT WORKSHOP

A physical 5-day workshop for potential Technology Transfer Officers (TTOs) was carried to train personnel in the act of Technology Transfer as part of the drive to improve the human capacity in the University Innovation and Technology Management Office (ITMO).

Target Participants

The Technology Management Workshop was advertised in the University bulletin (https://unilag.edu.ng/?p=15050) by the University's Innovation and Technology Management Office (ITMO) and made open and free for non-academic staff of the University while the Center invited members of its faculty to also participate.

Objectives of the 5-Day Workshop

- 1. To attract non-faculty members of staff in the University to the Technology Management profession
- 2. To empower non-faculty members of staff in the University with technology management skills required to work in ITMO.
- 3. To assess the capability of workshop trainees as potential TTOs after the workshop

Expected Outcome of the 5-Day Workshop

At the end of the workshop,

- 1. Some non-faculty staff of the University would have become skilled in the task of technology Management
- 2. Some of the trained staff would be recommended for transfer to the ITMO as TTOs, since there is an embargo on fresh employment in the University
- 3. The University would begin to record successful technology licenses and start-ups as product of the ITMO in the nearest future.

Participants

Twenty-three persons applied, however sixteen non-academic and four faculty staff participated in the workshop. Five investors along with the Chief Facilitator rated the performance of the participants at the mock pitching and negotiation session.

The Chief Facilitator was Ms. Thandiwe Maretlane from South Africa. Thandiwe works in academia as a technology transfer specialist in the division of Innovation and Commercialization, at Stellenbosch University, South Africa She has high interest in academic entrepreneurship and innovation for economic development. She previously worked in the mining industry as an extractive metallurgist, where she majored in hydrobased processes of gold extraction. She manages a diverse portfolio of projects in biochemistry, biotechnology, physical sciences, and polymers. Her responsibilities are offering entrepreneurial support to students and stuff, identifying Intellectual property and commercialization of research. Her academic accolades include an MBA (candidate), MPhil. Science and Technology Studies (Scientometrics), PGDip. Intellectual Property Law, BSc. Hons. Technology Management, and B.Tech. Degree Engineering Metallurgy. She is a member of Association of European Science & Technology Transfer Professionals (ASTP), Association of University Technology Managers (AUTM), Southern African Research and Innovation Management Association (SARIMA) and Licensing Executive Society (LES.). The Center Leader, Dr Omobolanle Ade-Ademilua coordinated the workshop as a Research Commercialisation Expert while Dr Ifeoma Oluwasemilore, an intellectual property expert and member of the Center handled the IP module.
